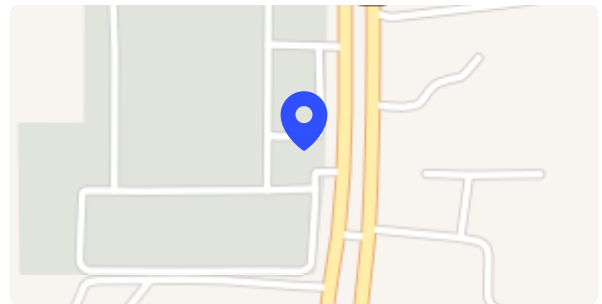
Jesse was also a proud Army veteran having served three tours in the Vietnam War. He served his country in the Special Forces. Jesse will be missed by all who know and love him.

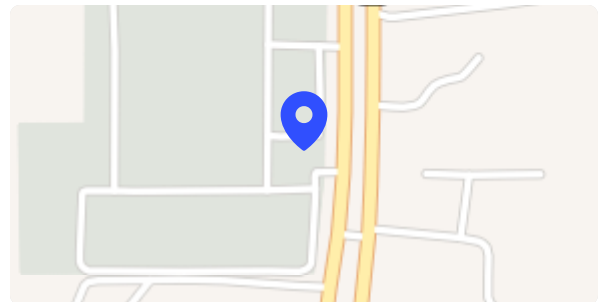

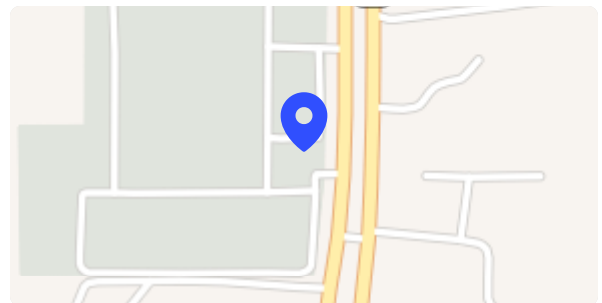
